◆ **Certified Veterinary Technician**

A CVT has graduated from an AVMA-accredited program and passed the Veterinary Technician National Exam. Continuing Education credits are required to maintain certification. CACVT accepts transfers from other states. Also referred to as the "Active" category.

◆ **Student Membership**

An individual currently enrolled in an AVMA-accredited program in veterinary technology.

◆ **Associate Membership**

This category includes veterinarians, credentialed technicians in other states, assistants, and receptionists. Hospitals may purchase the *Techniques* newsletter to keep their employees informed.

◆ **In-active Status**

For current CVT members who need a brief sabbatical from the full status category.

◆ **Retired Status**
