Membership Categories

CACVT offers many different types of membership categories.

- ◆ **Certified Veterinary Technician (CVT):** graduates from an AVMA-accredited program and passes the Veterinary Technician National Exam (based on the PES criterion reference score). Continuing Education credits are required to maintain certification.
- ◆ **Student Membership:** an individual currently enrolled in an AVMA-accredited program in veterinary technology.
- ◆ **Associate Membership:** include veterinarians, assistants, and receptionists. Hospitals may purchase the Techniques newsletter to keep their employees informed.
- ◆ **In-active Status:** For current CVT members who need a brief sabbatical from the full status category.
